Doug Soldat is a professor & turfgrass extension specialist & chair of the Dept. of Soil Science at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Doug completed his B.S. & M.S. degrees in Soil Science from UW-Madison & earned a Ph.D. in Plant Science from Cornell University. His research & outreach programs are focused on improving turfgrass nutrient & water use efficiency. Doug teaches

courses on turfgrass management & general soil science at the University of Wisconsin.



Greg Lush - Founder of Last Mile Worker Solutions, a transformation services consulting practice. Greg has spent his career working with organizations and helping them realize their modernization aspirations. His perspectives are derived from decades of experience as a Chief Information Officer within service companies. Often Greg is referred to as a

Dr. J. M. Vargas has been a professor of Plant Pathology at Michigan State University for the past 53 years where he has been involved in teaching, research, and extension. He received his B.S. degree from the University of Rhode Island in 1963, his M.S. from Oklahoma State University in 1965, and his Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota in 1968. He has published over 200

articles on turfgrass diseases and related subjects. He has given over 1000 presentations at various turfgrass conferences throughout the world including Australia, Argentina, China, France, Germany, Ireland, England, Mexico, New Zealand, Malaysia, Spain, Austria, Japan, Korea, Portugal, Slovenia and South Africa. He has also published the most widely used turfgrass disease book entitled "Management of Turfgrass Diseases" and co authored two other books "Poa annua: Physiology, Culture, and Control of Annual Bluegrass" and "The Turf Problem Solver".



Thomas A. Nikolai, Ph.D. has been performing turfgrass research and teaching at Michigan State University since 1992. Areas of research interest include cultural and mechanical practices and relevant classes he has taught include, Turfgrass and the Environment, Pesticide and Fertilizer Technology, Fundamentals of Soils, and Turfgrass
